The statue was designed (2) _____ Frédéric Auguste Bartholdi, and its metal framework was created by Gustave Eiffel. Made of copper, it stands 93 meters tall from the base to the top of the torch. In her right hand, the statue holds a torch, which represents light (3) _____ hope. In her left hand, she carries a tablet with the date "July 4, 1776," the day (4) _____ United States became independent. At her feet, broken chains show freedom from oppression. (5) _____ many immigrants arriving in New York, the statue was a sign of a new beginning. Today, it is one of the most visited landmarks in the world and a strong symbol of democracy and human rights.
