### **A. The Statue of Liberty**

The Statue of Liberty is a famous symbol (0) of freedom for American people. It stands (1) \_\_\_\_\_ Liberty Island in New York Harbor and was a gift from France in 1886 to celebrate 100 years of American independence. The statue was designed (2) \_\_\_\_\_ Frédéric Auguste Bartholdi, and its metal framework was created by Gustave Eiffel. Made of copper, it stands 93 meters tall from the base to the top of the torch. In her right hand, the statue holds a torch, which represents light (3) \_\_\_\_\_ hope. In her left hand, she carries a tablet with the date "July 4, 1776," the day (4) \_\_\_\_\_ United States became independent. At her feet, broken chains show freedom from oppression. (5) \_\_\_\_\_ many immigrants arriving in New York, the statue was a sign of a new beginning. Today, it is one of the most visited landmarks in the world and a strong symbol of democracy and human rights.

### **B. Good Manners**
